Millions have walked Spain's Way of St. James (Camino de Santiago) in the last 1200 years. Tens of thousands now tackle this route each year. It was recently portrayed in a film, *The Way*, starring Martin Sheen and Emilio Estevez.

James (son of Zebedee) was in the inner circle of disciples and is credited with bringing the gospel to Spain. Numerous historical leaders walked this route (Francis of Assisi, Dante Alighieri, Brigid of Sweden). On

pilgrimage people find their callings and learn invaluable leadership lessons: listening to the journey of others;



sharing leadership; challenging oneself physically, mentally and emotionally; encountering God in unexpected ways; walking by faith; staying focused on a goal while collaborating with others; building community and trust.

Over **8 days**, the group covers the last **120 kilometers** of the Camino, qualifying for the much-coveted Compostela certificate offered by the Santiago Cathedral.

- 3. A photo copy of the photo page of your passport

If you are taking the Leadership Pilgrimage on the Camino de Santiago (LEAD 670) course, note that the course requires participation on the tour.
