Day 1 Fri, Sep 10 Belleville to Vancouver

Morning departure to Toronto Pearson airport for flight to Vancouver. Once a trading post and a rough-and-tumble sawmilling settlement, today modern Vancouver, is many things. It's a bustling seaport and a hub for outdoor enthusiasts. Transfer and overnight Vancouver hotel TBA.

Day 2 Sat, Sep 11 Vancouver

Morning at leisure to explore Vancouver. Transfer to Canada Place pier and embark on the Koningsdam at 3:00 pm PDT.

ITINERARY

Day 3 Sun, Sep 12 Scenic Cruising: The Inside Passage

Alaska's Inside Passage is a protected network of waterways that wind through glacier-cut fjords and lush temperate rain forests along the rugged coast of Southeast Alaska. Arguably one of the greatest cruising routes in the world, the Inside Passage stretches through stunning landscapes, from Misty Fjords National Monument to famed Glacier Bay National Park & Preserve.

Day 4 Mon, Sep 13 Juneau, Alaska, US

Juneau, Alaska may well be the most remote, most beautiful and strangest state capital in the United States. Surrounded by water, forest, and mountains, you can hike a glacier, eat fresh-caught fish on a seaside patio and tour a grand capitol building all in one day.

Day 5 Tue, Sep 14 Skagway, Alaska, US

At the height of the Klondike Gold Rush, the port town of Skagway served as the primary gateway to the legendary gold fields, and quickly grew into Alaska's largest settlement. At every turn, you'll find yourself immersed in gold rush lore, from the infamous Red Onion Saloon that still keeps a pistol that Wyatt Earp left behind enroute to the Klondike, to the White Pass & Yukon Route Railroad, a classic narrow-gauge railway that traverses rugged mountains and passes cascading waterfalls and towering glaciers as it connects Skagway to Whitehorse deep in the Yukon. Much of the town has been preserved as part of the Klondike Gold Rush National Historical Park, where rangers offer free walking tours around the historic district. Here you'll also find a vibrant local community, home to a rich collection of local galleries, curio shops and restaurants serving seafood plucked fresh from nearby waters.

Day 6 Wed, Sep 15 Scenic Cruising: Glacier Bay

Frosted crags descend into mossy forests and a 457-meter-deep (1,500-foot-deep) fjord at this World Heritage Site, which is also one of the planet's largest biosphere reserves. Stone, ice and water continue to collide, sculpting a dramatic landscape that is the crown jewel of southeastern Alaska's natural wonders. Even in spring, be prepared for any weather—especially rain! Pack a hat, gloves, wool or fleece layers, a warm coat and waterproof gear if you want to admire the landscape from the open deck of your ship.

Day 7 Thu, Sep 16 Ketchikan, Alaska, US

Ketchikan has long been an important hub of the salmon-fishing and -packing industries—you can try your luck on a sportfishing excursion or simply savor the fresh seafood at one of the local restaurants. It is also one of the best spots along the Inside Passage to explore the rich cultural sights of Native Alaskan nations like the Tlingit, Haida and Tsimshian. You can see intricately carved totem poles at the Totem Heritage Center and Totem Bight State Park, while the attractions of Saxman Village just outside of Ketchikan offers the chance to see Tlingit culture in action, with working carvers and a dance show in the clan house. And leave time to explore the sights in the town itself, including historic Creek Street, a boardwalk built over the Ketchikan Creek, where you can shop for souvenirs, smoked salmon and local art, while exploring gold rush—era tourist attractions like Dolly's House Museum.

Day 8 Fri, Sep 17 Scenic Cruising: The Inside Passage

Sailing the Inside Passage offers opportunities to spot some of Alaska's most iconic wildlife, with humpback whales and orca plying the bountiful waters alongside the ships, bald eagles soaring overhead and brown bears lumbering on the shoreline.

Disembark the Koningsdam and transfer to Vancouver International Airport for your return flight to Toronto and transfer to Belleville.

About Your Ship

Holland America's **Koningsdam** features a total of 1,331 passenger cabins across 12 decks and 588 crew cabins for a maximum capacity of 4,173 passengers and crew. Much of Koningsdam, including the passenger decks, stairwells, and passageways, is influenced by music in naming, decor, and entertainment. Centered on the lower decks are the ship's main entertainment venues, including the main theater and three stages and lounges designed to offer different genres of live music. Dining establishments are also located nearby and cater to different tastes and purposes, including a French bistro, an Italian restaurant, a cooking demonstration venue, a winemaking venue, a dining room, and a café. Aboard the ship, features include a spa, pools housed under a magrodome, and a cruise ship poolside theater, as well as additional dining venues, including a buffet and a pan-Asian restaurant.

Deposit

A guaranteed deposit of \$680 per person is payable at time of booking and includes a \$197.00 per person professional service fee. This deposit is NONREFUNDABLE. Insurance, which is strongly recommended, must be purchased at time of deposit.

Balance of Payment

Guaranteed balance of payment required June 02, 2027. If the balance is not paid by the stipulated date, the right is reserved to cancel the booking(s) without further notice and without refund of deposit.

Credit Card Payments

Holland America | Air Canada | Marlin Travel will accept the following credit cards: Visa, MasterCard or American Express for deposits and full/final payments. Your authorization to use your Credit Card number for deposit and/or final payment indicates your compliance with our booking terms and conditions, whether or not you have actually signed the appropriate draft. Verbal authorization of your Credit Card confirms your reservation.

Cancellations

Cancellations received more than 100 days prior to departure will incur loss of the non-refundable deposit as specified above. Cancellations received 100 days or less prior to departure will be levied a fee of 100% of the tour cost. Other specific supplier and airline cancellation penalties may apply in addition to cancellation and amendment fees charged by Marlin Travel. There will be no refund for unused land arrangements after departure. All cancellations required in writing.

Insurance

Baggage Allowance

Unless otherwise noted on individual airline/cruise line documentation, each person is entitled to two pieces of paid checked baggage with a total weight of 23kg (50lbs). Checked baggage fees vary by airline. Unless insured, all baggage remains at the owner's responsibility throughout the trip.

Passports/Visas/Travel Documents

A passport valid for six months beyond date of travel is required for entry into all countries. If you are not travelling on a Canadian passport, it is imperative that you also check visa requirements for all of the destinations you will be travelling to or transiting through.

It is also the passenger(s) responsibility to obtain at the passenger(s) own expense all documentation required by all relevant government authorities. We suggest that prior to departure, the passenger(s) ascertain(s) the documentation required. In the event the passenger does not possess the proper documentation required, be aware that the carrier(s) reserve(s) the right to refuse the passenger(s) and no refund will be permitted. Ultimately, it is your responsibility to ensure you have the correct documentation.
