Daily Itinerary:

September 3rd, 2021

Depart your hometown and take an overnight flight across the Atlantic.

September 4th, 2021

Upon arrival into Dublin, enjoy a breakfast stop before travelling north to Belfast where you will set off on a panoramic tour. Following the tour, entrance to the Titanic Belfast is included where you can learn about the evolution of the Titanic. In the evening, join your fellow travelers for a Welcome Dinner in the hotel restaurant.

Dinner/ Overnight, Europa Hotel, Belfast

September 5th, 2021

This morning you will drive along the coast to experience one of Ireland's popular scenic routes. You will see the "Nine Glens of Antrim" and stop to visit the Giant's Causeway. Continue to Derry to go on a walking tour to see the city's sites. Travel to Donegal, where you will check in for dinner and overnight stay.

Dinner/ Overnight, Mill Park Hotel, Donegal

September 6th, 2021

Today visit Slieve League Sea Cliffs. Travel to Ardara to see demonstrations of spinning, weaving and knitting at Triona Designs. Return to Donegal, where you are free for individual pursuits and dining.

Overnight, Mill Park Hotel, Donegal

September 7th, 2021

This morning, a stop in the town of Moycullen and visit the Connemara Marble Factory. Continue to Dromoland Castle Hotel, one of Ireland's finest castle hotels and check in. Spend the balance of the afternoon relaxing or exploring in this lavish setting. In the evening, join your fellow travellers for a superb hotel dinner.

Dinner/ Overnight, Dromoland Castle Hotel, Shannon

September 8th, 2021

Leaving Dromoland Castle pass through the Burren, an area of rocky limestone hills where a number of unique flowers thrive.

Next, drive along the coast of County Clare to visit the Cliffs of Moher which overlook the shimmering Atlantic Ocean.

Continue to Durty Nelly's Pub for an independent drink which stands in the shadow of Bunratty Castle and has been in business for about two centuries. After your visit, travel to the Killarney and check into your hotel. Tonight, you are free to dine at one of the many restaurants or pubs scattered throughout the town.

Overnight, International Hotel, Killarney



After breakfast, take a horse-drawn jaunting car ride through the grounds of the Killarney National Park. Next, drive through the scenic half Ring of Kerry, including a stop at Moll's Gap to enjoy its views over the three lakes. Continue on to visit the Kissane Sheep Farm, a traditional sheep farm run. Finally, make your way to the Gap of Dunloe to have an early dinner at Heather's Restaurant, which is in Moriarty's Gift Shop. The remainder of the evening at leisure in Killarney.

Dinner/ Overnight, International Hotel, Killarney

September 10th, 2021

Depart Killarney, journey through countryside to Blarney, where you can climb the Blarney Castle and kiss the famous "Stone of Eloquence." Next, drive to County Tipperary and visit Cahir Castle, stronghold of the powerful Butler family. The castle is located on an island site with buildings dating from the 13th–19th centuries. Afterwards, check into your Kilkenny for your overnight stay. This evening, dinner is at a local venue.

Dinner/ Overnight, Ormonde Hotel, Kilkenny

September 11th, 2021

After breakfast, visit Kilkenny Castle, home of the Butlers, Earls and Dukes of Ormonde. Continue on to visit the Irish National Stud, and take a walk around the truly spectacular Japanese Gardens. Then drive to the bustling city of Dublin and check into your hotel. Tonight, you are free to dine at one of the many restaurants or pubs scattered throughout the city.

Overnight, Gresham Hotel, Dublin

September 12th, 2021

Set off with a local guide who will show you around Dublin. The city has been molded through the centuries by economic, political and artistic influences that has shaped its architecture. Stop at Trinity College to see the Book of Kells. Tour Guinness Storehouse to see exhibits on how this world-famous stout was first created and why it is so popular today. Finish your visit in the roof-top bar, where you can sample a draft of Guinness. The afternoon is free to sightsee and shop. This evening, head to Taylors Three Rock for an Irish dinner with lively music and dance.

Farewell Dinner/Overnight, Gresham Hotel, Dublin

September 13th, 2021

After breakfast transfer to Dublin Airport to check in for your flight. You may want to do some last minutes shopping at the duty free stores before boarding your aircraft for your flight back to Canada.
