Day 01

Paris

Welcome to France. This unique journey will showcase the wonders of Normandy, from its famous historical figures to moving battlefields and grand châteaux. Board your 5-star Scenic Space-Ship for a cruise you will treasure forever.

Day 02

Les Andelys

Enjoy a relaxed morning on board as you cruise gently along the Seine to Les Andelys, arriving just after lunch. This pretty, waterside village dates back almost 900 years. This afternoon, take a guided tour of the town with a visit to Château Gaillard, or hike to the hilltop château accompanied by Richard the Lionheart himself. Alternatively, visit Château Gaillon and learn about its role as a cultural and architectural milestone in French history or visit a cider farm where you can taste one of Normandy's most famous products.

Day 03

Rouen

Rouen's history spans over 2,000 years, from Viking legends to its significant role in both World Wars. Partake in a guided walking tour or be entertained by Viking warlord, Rollo "The Walker" dressed in authentic attire. Or join a local photographer on an immersive excursion through the town, capturing hidden gems. This afternoon enjoy an on board lecture about what it was like to be a Tommy (British) soldier during WWI.

Day 04

Rouen

Perhaps spend the day paying your respects to the brave heroes who sacrificed so much at the Somme Battlefields, an experience only available with Scenic. Explore the Australian National Memorial and either Newfoundland Memorial Park or Thiepval Memorial before arriving at Lochnagar Crater. Alternatively, guests can indulge in a taste of Normandy, savouring the region's cheese and cider delicacies. Tonight, indulge in a delectable dessert buffet on board including exquisite French pastries.

Day 05

Rouen > Honfleur

Enjoy another relaxed morning on board as we cruise west to Honfleur, on the edge of the English Channel. A guided walking tour of the city will show you its charming inner harbour, the Church of Sainte-Catherine and the Garden of Personalities, before you can explore on your own with some free time. Tonight, history comes alive with an engaging on board lecture about Operation Fortitude during the D-Day campaign. Tonight, we dock in the heart of Honfleur.

Day 06

Honfleur

Choose between three full-day tours to the Normandy Beaches where the D-Day landings took place, each focused on either the American, British or Canadian forces. Alternatively, visit the beautiful medieval Bayeux to wander its cobblestone streets and see the grand Gothic cathedral.

Day 07

Honfleur > Caudebec-en-Caux

Begin cruising inland early this morning to the small town of Caudebec-en-Caux. History enthusiasts can choose to learn the stories of the French Resistance during WWII on a guided tour or you may like to visit the Palais Benedictine in nearby Fécamp and taste its eponymous liqueur. Alternatively, marvel at Normandy's famed Abbeys Road, lined with a number of grand cathedrals. Active travellers can choose to cycle to the village of Villequier on an e-bike and visit the Victor Hugo Museum.

Day 08

Vernon > La Roche-Guyon

Historically a border town between the Duchy of Normandy and the Kingdom of France, Vernon has a rich heritage and many distinctive buildings. Nearby Giverny was the home of impressionist artist



Claude Monet for more than 40 years. Journey by coach or e-bike to the town before visiting his former residence and exploring his beautiful house and gardens. If you feel inspired, this afternoon you can join an on board painting class.

Enrich

Tonight, experience the opulence and grandeur of yesteryear as you enjoy an exclusive classical concert performed by the region's most renowned musicians inside the spectacular Château de la Roche-Guyon. An imposing fortress with a history spanning over 1,000 years, is carved into a chalk cliff overlooking the Seine Valley, showcasing a blend of medieval, Renaissance, and 18th-century architectural styles.

Day 09

Conflans > Paris

The medieval village of Conflans sits on the northern outskirts of Paris. Choose to see its most famous sites on an active walking tour, before spending some free time at the Musée de la Batellerie (Inland Waterways Museum). Or travel to the village of Auvers-sur-Oise, where Vincent van Gogh lived for the last few months of his life, and where he created over 70 paintings and sketches including some of his most famous works. Alternatively, take a guided tour of the magnificent Chantilly Castle or visit Château de Malmaison, the private residence of Napoleon Bonaparte and his wife Josephine. Depart for the centre of Paris early this afternoon.

Day 10

Paris

Enjoy a full day in the French capital. First time visitors may like to choose a panoramic coach tour of the city's highlights, like the iconic Eiffel Tower, Champs-Élysées and Arc de Triomphe. If you're already familiar with the city of light, you can take a tour of the spectacular Palais Garnier opera house or travel to the Vaux-le-Vicomte Palace, the inspiration for Louis XIV's opulent Palace of Versailles. Alternatively, explore the boho neighbourhood of Marais with a local guide and sample delicious French pastries.

Day 11

Paris

Your journey concludes this morning. Disembark after breakfast, taking with you many wonderful memories of this unique part of France.
